Root balls are lifted from the fields with a full soil ball around the roots. They are available October to May.

Hazel is a native deciduous hedging plant, suitable both as a component in a mixed native hedge or as a single species hedge. Hazel has fluffy yellow catkins early in the year and edible nuts in autumn. It is fine in most free draining soils and windy/exposed sites and is shade tolerant.
